- ✓ Appropriate Teaching credential (Dip. Ed., B. Ed., E.C.E., E.A.)
- ✓ Ability to speak, read and write Mohawk to a high level of language proficiency is preferred **but not mandatory**
- ✓ Willingness to learn and use Kanyen'kéha daily **is required**
- ✓ Knowledge and appreciation for Mohawk language, culture and tradition
- ✓ Willingness to engage in Waldorf methodologies
